People with a learning disability can get an Annual Health Check.

In an Annual Health Check a doctor checks if you are healthy.

The doctor can tell you what you need to help you to be healthy.




It is really important for people with a learning disability to have a health check.

People with a learning disability can get more health problems than people who do not have a learning disability.



You can have 1 Annual Health Check every year.

It is a very good idea to go every year.



The health check should take about 45 minutes.

The doctor should ask about lots of things.



A nurse might help the doctor with some parts of the check.

You might meet with the nurse in another room.



Some doctors surgeries do not do health checks.

If your surgery does not, they should be able to help you find a surgery that does.




After your annual health check, your doctor should help you make an easy read **health action plan**.
